Greetings cat lovers and generous supporters of Cat Rescue and Adoption Network.

2020 will surely be a year that no one will forget. COVID was not in our vocabulary in 2019 and now it is present in everything we do. Someone asked me recently if CRAN has fewer kitties this year; in fact, while in 2019 we had an incredibly busy year, 2020 will break all records for rescues and surrenders, and for adoptions!

At this time last year, we had rescued about 580 cats and kittens. As I write this, we have exceeded 800 rescues. Fortunately, we also have record-breaking numbers of foster families, a strong core group of volunteers and adoptions are up! Last year adoptions, through October, stood at 424 compared to 550+ to date this year!

At the end of 2019 we planned for 600 rescues and adoptions in 2020. The budget we set is currently addressing the needs of closer to 900 cats and kittens in our care. We are up nearly 40% over budget in both rescues and adoptions. This means we are also up nearly 40% over expectations for special-needs cats and kittens as well.

Typically, 75% of our annual budget goes to medical care with the largest portion going to spay/neuter and adoption preparation.

We continue to take in cats from bereaved families, financially strapped families, and community members in need. Kittens have been found under houses, under decks, bramble bushes, and even a feed sack, to name just a few discovery spots.

We come to you again with an opportunity to get involved. Because of COVID, we lost 2 months of low cost spay/neuter opportunities in Oregon. Medical costs have increased due to COVID precautions. CRAN is fortunate to have partnerships with several veterinary clinics in the Eugene-Springfield area, who help CRAN in a variety of ways.
