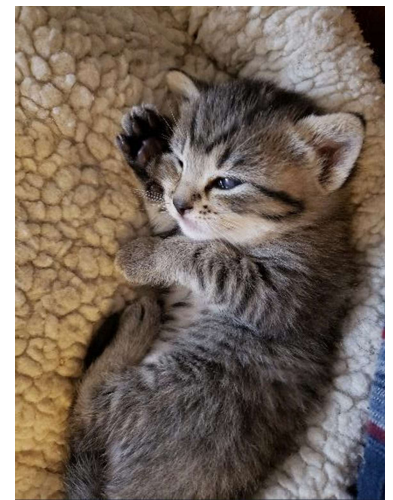


Kitten season is here! Queens are in heat right now and many are already pregnant. In less than 65 days, kittens will be popping out all across Lane County!



Help us be ready to care for these adorable, fragile fluffballs and their parents. We need your support to spay or neuter every one of them, to help reduce the number of unowned, free-roaming cats in our community. Your financial contribution will also help feed the orphaned kittens, heal their injuries and illnesses, and vaccinate them – all while we search for loving families to adopt each one.

Bottle babies – orphan kittens who must be handfed every 2 to 4 hours for the first weeks of their life – are especially common in Spring. These tiny newborns, weighing just about 3 ounces, will die without help eating, going potty, even staying warm. It takes skilled, dedicated volunteers to keep them alive. We are so grateful to have volunteers on our team with the knowledge and commitment for this vital task.



Since Cat Rescue and Adoption Network (CRAN) was founded in 2006, we have saved nearly 8,000 cats and kittens right here in Lane County.

Thanks to your generosity in 2024, CRAN:

- Cared for 636 cats and kittens
- Found loving homes for 343 cats and kittens
- Spayed or neutered 435 cats, including 124 community cats

And we did it all on a modest budget of just over \$275,000, powered by the tireless work of countless volunteers. CRAN volunteers open their homes to abandoned cats and kittens, teach them to trust people, and help them grow into healthy, adoptable, confident cats.

CRAN receives no government funding for this essential work – we rely entirely on adoption fees and financial donations from compassionate cat lovers like you. In fact 86% of our 2025 budget is allocated to spay/neuter surgeries, Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) of free roaming cats, and medical expenses for the cats and kittens in our care.



Our goal is to raise \$40,000 with this campaign to ensure we're ready for the wave of kittens that will soon arrive. To kick off the campaign, generous donors have funded a \$10,000 Matching Challenge. This means that every dollar you donate by April 30 up to \$10,000 will be matched – effectively doubling your gift!
