In 2021, we anticipate more than 850 cats and kittens will have been cared for by CRAN volunteers after spay and neuter surgeries, serious injuries and illnesses, all on the way to finding their forever homes. Kittens found by the side of a road. Cats left bewildered and abandoned due to death, or family financial disaster. Pregnant stray kitties who gave birth the day after we took them in. Feral kitties spayed or neutered, to control colony populations. We were able to care for all of these cats and kittens because of you.

Thanks to you, Merlot, our brave little megaesophagus kitten, brightened all of our days with her sparkly attitude even in the face of severe illness. She taught us that what we can't overcome, we can still face down with determination and grab the joy of each day.

Theo, Noel, Owen, Wispy, Sprinkles and Cheeto didn't ask to have a life-threatening diagnosis of feline leukemia, but each of them has graced our volunteers with sweet attitudes, courage, grace, and kitten catitude because of your help.



Awe's owner had to surrender her due to financial hardship. At first, Awe seemed to be unreachable, but with your help and her foster's gentle encouragement she found that she can adapt to a new landscape and a new life.



Buttercup came into our care heavily pregnant, anemic and severely underweight, but she gave birth to 5 gorgeous kittens, took care of them, and now she is taking

care of her own needs – filling out, playing without the responsibility of caring for kittens, and embracing her new opportunities because of you.

Since 2007, CRAN has continued to expand the numbers of cats and kittens we rescue each year and expand programs and services in the community with contributions from community members like yourself. CRAN facilitated TNR (trap-neuter-return) surgeries for many more cats this year than we have in the past several years. Owing to the generosity of donors we now have a fund dedicated to spay and neuter surgeries for our feral friends and to date this year have funded feral packages for 235 cats.
